We like the smooth, paper-like cover and the fact that these are an eco-nappy. 70% biodegradable and compostable! All-natural ingredients but they still have the features of other nappies. We really like the fact that they don't have a strong chemical smell!

We don't like the fact that value-for-money is not that crash-hot. These nappies are on a par, cost-wise to other eco-brands such as Seventh Generation and Babylove Ecobots. Other Mums say... Margaret, from Sydney says....

"I have been using Nature's Babycare nappies since soon after my son was born 8 months ago and I think they are fantastic. I have tried other 'eco-friendly' nappies but none have been as good as Nature Babycare.
